"Site of Mayfield, until a few years ago the walls of what was once a square stone house, built in the late eighteenth or early nineteenth century, were still standing. Nathaniel Harris received in 1717 the original patent to this land, then known as Buckhele. His daughter Ann Frances became the wife of Howson Hooe who died in 1780.
