" A private road that reaches, after dwindling to a footpath, the tottering BAILEY HOUSE about a mile from the highway. The weather-beaten frame structure spreads out low on a U-plan beneath a vast oak and a roof so mossy and lichen-covered that it resembles thatch. A porch fills in the U. At each end is a stone outside chimney. That on the south is half hidden by a kitchen wing, which - built partly of logs - may antedate the rest of the building. West of the house, beyond a field, is an old graveyard where tombstones sentimentally memorialize Naomi Callender (1793-1861), Dr. Hiram Eastman (1802-1863), and David Eastman (1771-1863). A single slab with the date 1828 bears the names, Margaret Eastman, and William Callender."
