Historic Name: Collins House

Date or Period: Mid-19<sup>th</sup> Century

Original Use: Residence

Vicinity: Lake Jackson

"Built in two stages, this house has both a one-story and a two-story section. It is built of frame and log on a stone foundation and has a metal-covered, gabled roof. A stone-and-brick chimney is in the one-story section, while the two-story section has an interior brick chimney. A high square porch spans the front of the building.
