“ Built around the turn of the century by John A. Cannon, a skilled Manassas builder, this two story home has a metal – covered hip roof. It is believed to have been a replica of Tudor Hall, a stylish, late-eighteenth-century mansion once located on the outskirts of Manassas. Elisha E. Meredith, the home’s first owner, was the county prosecuting attorney from 1876 to 1883, a state senator from 1883 to 1887, and a U. S. representative from 1891 to 1898.
